

Sir:

Office letter "Education 39347-1906" from the Acting Commissioner of Indian Affairs, dated the 8th instant, stating that Mrs. Lillian B. Adams has decided not to accept transfer from Haskell Institute to this school as assistant matron is at hand. We have no other recommendation to make with reference to filling this vacancy.
