
Sir:

I inclose herewith outline of first and second floor plan of cottage which will give a general idea of what I desire in the way of arrangement for the physician's cottage authorized in the Indian Bill for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1907; the amount appropriated being \$2500. The prominent feature desired is to have a comfortable, large living room, and front porch at least eight feet wide extending across the front of the building, which faces, practically, north, and to have the porch extend around the east side, the whole distance if possible, and if not, at least part of the way.

Will you kindly have the draftsman go over these outlines in accordance with the above requests and, so far as it is possible, plan a cottage, making whatever changes in location of closets, etc., that he may think will be an improvement on the plan outlined.

It would be a great accommodation to my proposed work here at the school if we could have the plans and specifications so that we could advertise for bids not later than the first of July.

as possible.

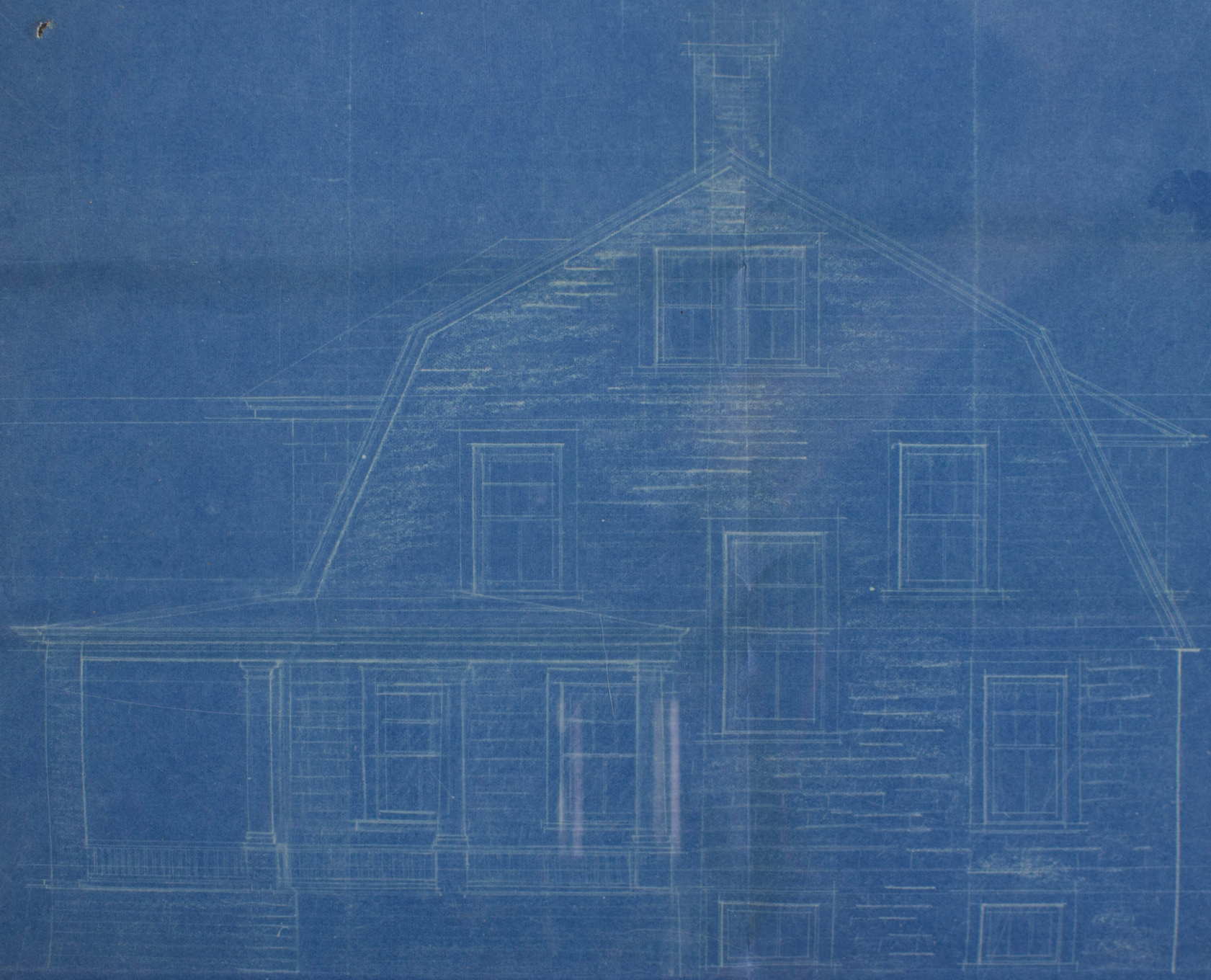

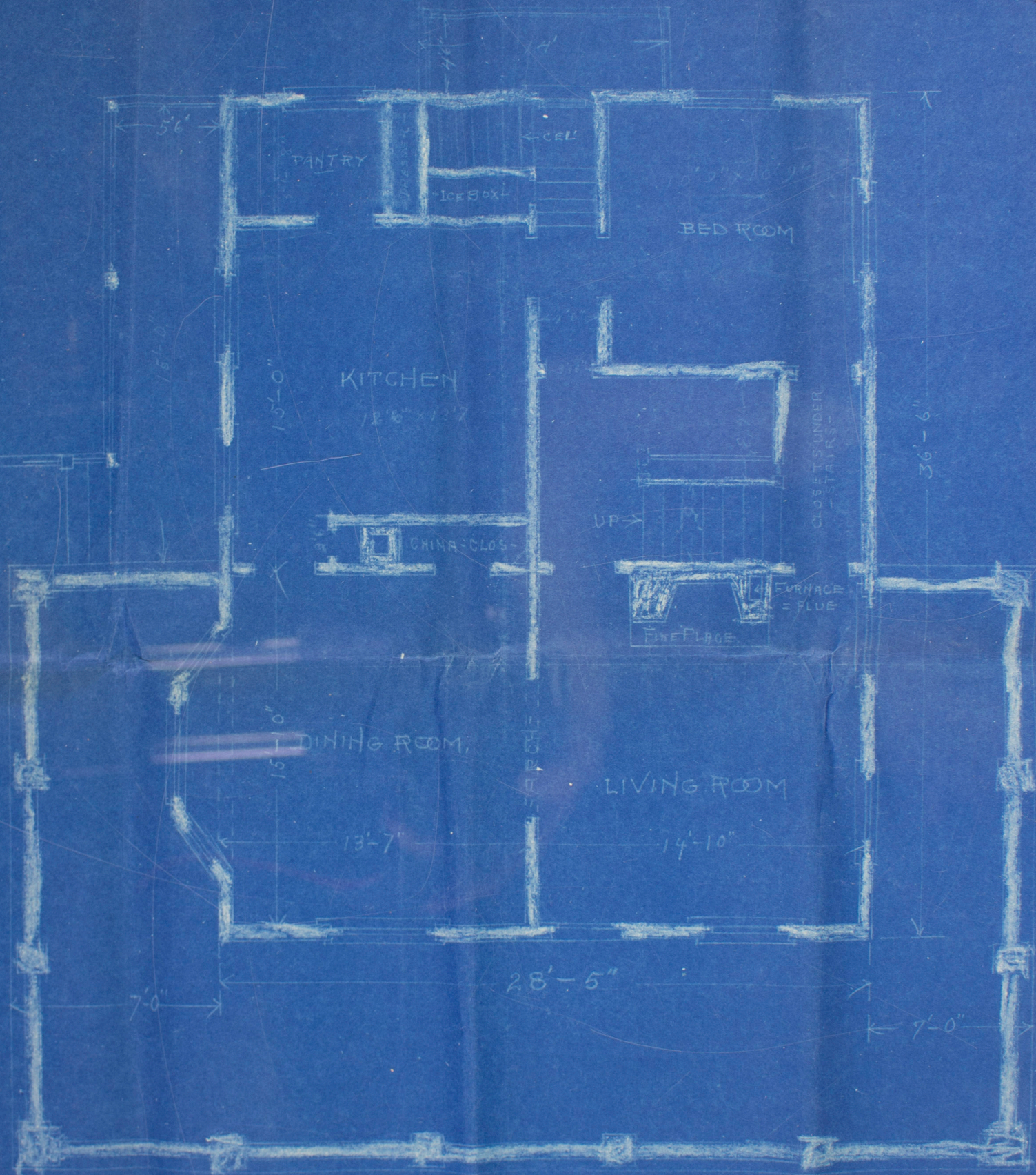

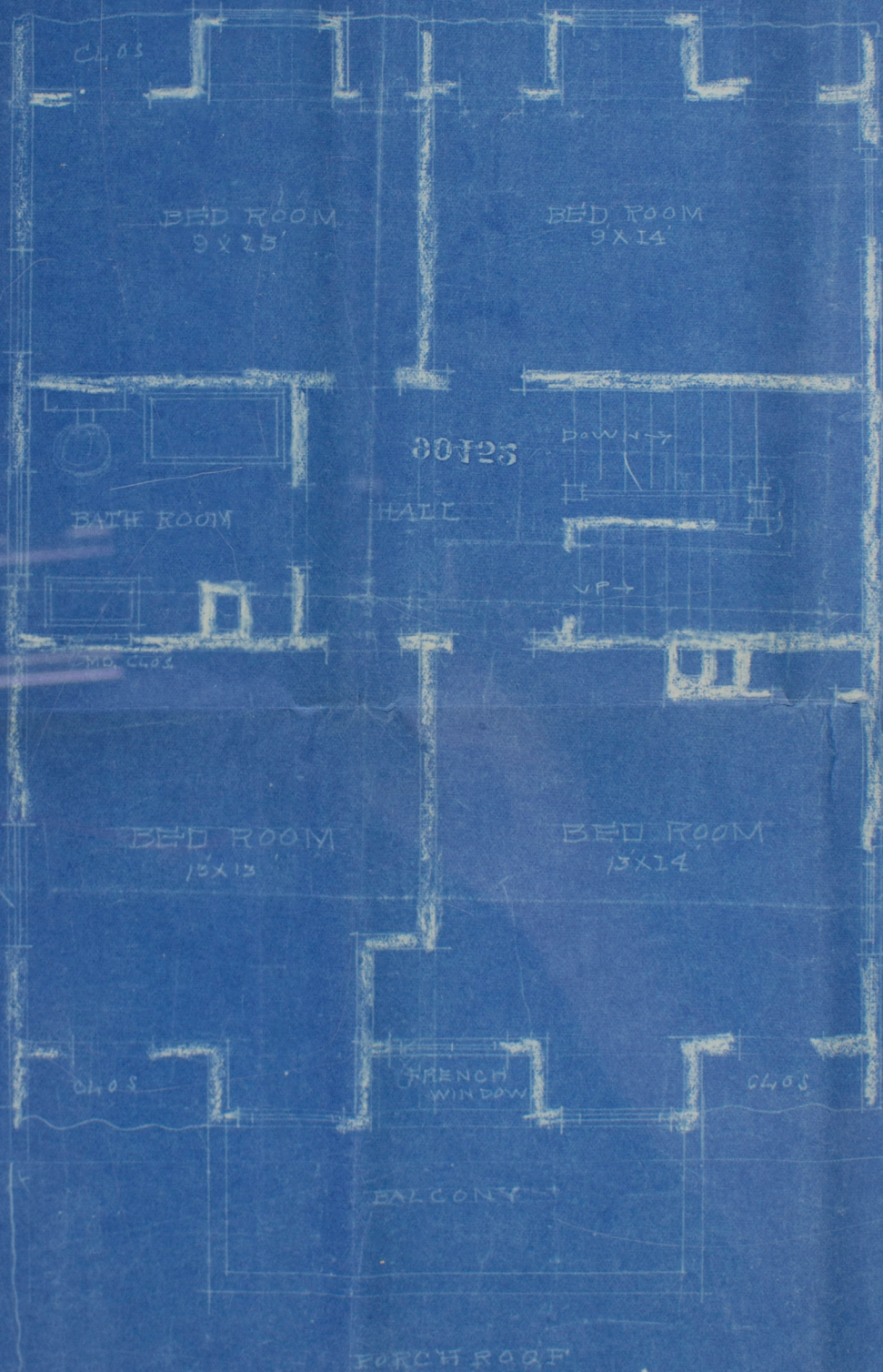
