
I enclose herewith voucher for transportation of fifteen Alaskan pupils to their homes, together with statements of ticket agents, making a total sum of \$1085.65 for which authority is hereby requested in accordance with instructions of Office letter, Finance, 56676-60246/06; July 30, 1906.

Owing to the large amount involved, the Railroad officials are desirous of immediate payment, and it was only by promising to bring the business to a conclusion with all possible speed that I was able to obtain the tickets charged in the enclosed. I trust that Departmental action can be taken, so as to enable me to keep my agreement with the railroads.

As this payment is to be made from the General Deficiency Bill, I presume it is necessary for me to make requisition on that fund separate from my regular support fund; I accordingly submit requisition for payment of the transportation of pupils above mentioned and others who will go later.
