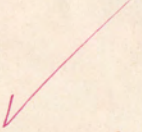


The Honorable,
