

Sir:

Referring to my letter of the 4th instant inclosing one from F. J. Packineau, Ft. Berthold Indian reservation, N. Dak., in regard to certain pupils who want to be enrolled as students at Carlisle and who are prevented from doing so by Superintendent Thomas, attention is respectfully invited to Office letter (Education 82896) dated the 4th instant, inclosing a letter from Supt. Thomas dated the 18th ult. in regard to the desire of the parents of Clara and Mattie Hall to have these girls enrolled as students at Carlisle. These two girls are among the number mentioned in Mr. Packineau's letter. We have this day written to Supt. Thomas inclosing application blanks for completion and approval of the transfer. If satisfactory they will be accepted and enrolled as students here. Similar action has been taken as to George Grinnell about whom Supt. Thomas also wrote your Office.
