

Referring to Office letter (Education 87034-06) dated the 8th ultimo, from the Acting Commissioner of Indian Affairs, advising us that George E. Balenti had failed in his examination for the position of teacher of mechanical drawing and asking a further recommendation as to permanently filling the position, you are advised that we have been unable to find a suitable person at the salary paid by this position and who would be eligible for appointment, to recommend to fill the same.
