

Sir:-

I enclose herewith resignation of Stacey Matlack as Assistant Disciplinarian at \$600.00 per annum, with my recommendation that it be accepted.

Under another cover by this mail I submit report of "Changes, Employees" showing resignation of Stacey Matlack and the appointment of Wallace Denny temporarily as his successor. Denny, one of our last years graduates, is very bright, energetic, active, of mixed blood and has for the past two or three years been an officer in the cadet corps and an assistant to the disciplinarian, who very highly recommends him for the position of Assistant Disciplinarian and says that he will be well satisfied if he can obtain his services. Under all the conditions I believe that he will be a much better assistant than anybody else that we can get for the place, even a white man, and I strongly recommend that he be allowed a competitive examination to be held in this office. I have nominated him temporarily.
