Sir:-

I have the honor to request that Mrs. Bertha Canfield, Seamstress, at this school at a salary of \$800.00 per annum, be transferred for the reason that I believe she lacks interest in her work and is therefore not as efficient as she should or could be. I believe she is capable of doing good work, but for many months I have been thinking of asking for her transfer, but have delayed doing so until firmly convinced that it is for the best interests of the school to do so. One of her assistants, Miss Beckie L. Goodyear, is capable of taking charge of the sewing room, and during the temporary absence of Mrs. Canfield gave better and more general satisfaction than Mrs. Canfield has during my administration of the school. Miss Goodyear has been a worthy employe for a number of years and should be promoted. In case Mrs. Canfield is transferred, I shall recommend that Miss Goodyear be advanced to the position at \$600.00 per annum, and that Miss Searight be promoted from \$300.00 to 360.00, the present salary of Miss Goodyear, so that the change will result in a saving of \$200.00 per annum, and I believe give better results.


I recommend that the transfer of Mrs. Canfield be made at the earliest possible moment. With your assistance I am determined
