As there has been no blacksmith yet appointed at this school, it becomes necessary to request continuation of Authority 102613, Education 98202, date of November 17th, 1906, for the employment of a horse shoer at \$4.00 per day for two days of each week, to continue until such time as a blacksmith may be appointed. The funds are available from wages saved by not employing a regular blacksmith.
