

Sir:-

I am in receipt of your office letter, "Education, 6877-1907" by the Chief Clerk, dated the 30th ult. stating that Allen S. Berry of 417 Division St., Jeffersonville, Ind. had been appointed Assistant Carpenter at this school. In connection with this appointment I desire to say that the carpenter work of the school is now well up and that the services of this appointee can be dispensed with I think for the remainder of the fiscal year, and I have to request that this be done, in view of the fact that our financial condition renders it desirable to effect a saving in this respect if possible. I would suggest that Mr. Berry be advised that his appointment is withdrawn, and that he be instructed not to proceed to Carlisle. In order that he might have notice at the earliest possible moment, I have this day written, advising him that your office would be requested to withdraw the appointment.
