Sir:

I have to request that you cause to be made for our outing office at this school an outing record book as per sample sheets herewith. The body of the book should comprise not to exceed 300 to 325 sheets. The sheets should be numbered only on the left hand page, as the same are bound in the volume. As the record extends across to the opposite page there is no need of numbering the right hand page. The index for the volume should be made as per sample inclosed, the same to comprise two pages or one full sheet for each letter. There is also inclosed a sample back for the volume. The book is desired to be uniform with several previous volumes made in the U. S. Government Printing Office for this school.

The book should be ready and in our hands not later than April 1st next. It is requested that about 25 extra sheets for the body of the book be sent to us. These need not be paged. They are wanted for use in continuing the record in the volume ^{now} in use for the present outing season.
