Sir:

I have the honor to report that on Monday following the date of my arrival here I learned that Major Mercer was absent in the South on official business. I waited until today for the purpose of learning the exact date of his return here and this morning ascertained from Mrs. Mercer through a telegram received by her that in all probability the Major would not be back for at least a week. The assistant superintendent is reluctant to take up the matter which brought me here and I do not think it wise to remain without your knowledge of the situation. I would therefore be pleased to have you express to me your wishes as to whether I shall remain awaiting Major Mercer's return to take up the matter of the individual Indian money, or whether I should proceed to carry out your instructions relative to proceeding from here to Sac and Fox, Iowa.
