Sir:

Enclosed herewith please find copy of lease drawn with Annie I Alexander and Laura E. Alexander, for a tract of land adjoining the school grounds, approved by the Secretary of the Interior, June 25, 1906, with the information that for the purpose of saving the balance of the rent from March 1st to the date of termination, the lessors have been notified that this lease would be abrogated on March 1st. A letter has been received from said lessors acknowledging due notice according to the terms, and stating that they understand that no payment of rent will be made after February 28, 1907.

A further reason for discontinuing the use of the land leased according to enclosed contract, is that, adding a portion of the school farm not specially needed at present for farming purposes, the athletic ground has been amply enlarged to suit all present uses of that tract, and the land covered by the lease with the

Alexanders is not necessary under present circumstances.,

Approval of the cancellation of the lease of the "Alexander Tract" for the balance of the fiscal year of 1907, commencing March 1st is therefore respectfully requested.
