

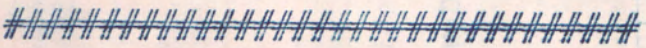

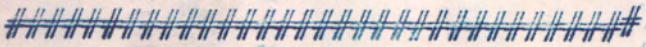



Replying to your Circular, Education No.146, I have to state that the only clerk at Carlisle who desires transfer is Mr. J.F.MacKey, clerk at \$1200.00 per annum, who wishes to be transferred to the Indian Office. He is also a candidate for transfer to the Field as Superintendent.

*L.B.H.* In this connection, I would say that I understand that Mrs. Laura B. Holderby of your Office is willing to transfer to Carlisle. If there is a prospect of arranging a transfer between Mr. MacKey and Mrs. Holderby, I wish that you would ask her to come to Carlisle and look over the school, and allow me the opportunity of having a personal talk with her, and then if satisfactory, I would be willing to arrange for a transfer of Mr. MacKey. I understand that the trip to Carlisle for that purpose would be agreeable to her.
