And this Company is hereby made the agent of the sender, without liability, to forward any messages over the lines of any other telegraph or cable company, and to pay for the same, in addition to the usual charge for repeated messages, viz.: one per cent. for any distance not exceeding 1,000 miles and two per cent. for any greater distance.
