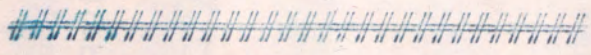

Sir:-

Referring to your Office letters, Education 25292/1907 and 26474/1907, dated March 15th and March 18th, from the Acting Commissioner of Indian Affairs, I have to state that the papers of Albert H. Gillett, Hugh W. Taylor, and Jesse W. Smith, in connection with their examinations for the position of teacher of Agriculture, have been carefully examined and that we think Mr. Taylor has the necessary qualifications for the work required in this position at Carlisle, and respectfully recommend that he be appointed thereto.

It is hoped that he will accept the appointment and report for duty at the earliest possible moment. Kindly impress upon him the fact that his services are earnestly desired as soon as possible in order that he may take up the supervision of farm, garden, and orchard work with the opening of spring.

In case Mr. Taylor declines, it is doubtful whether either Mr. Gillett or Mr. Smith would meet our requirements, and I do not now care to recommend the appointment of either.

The examination papers referred to are returned today under separate cover.
