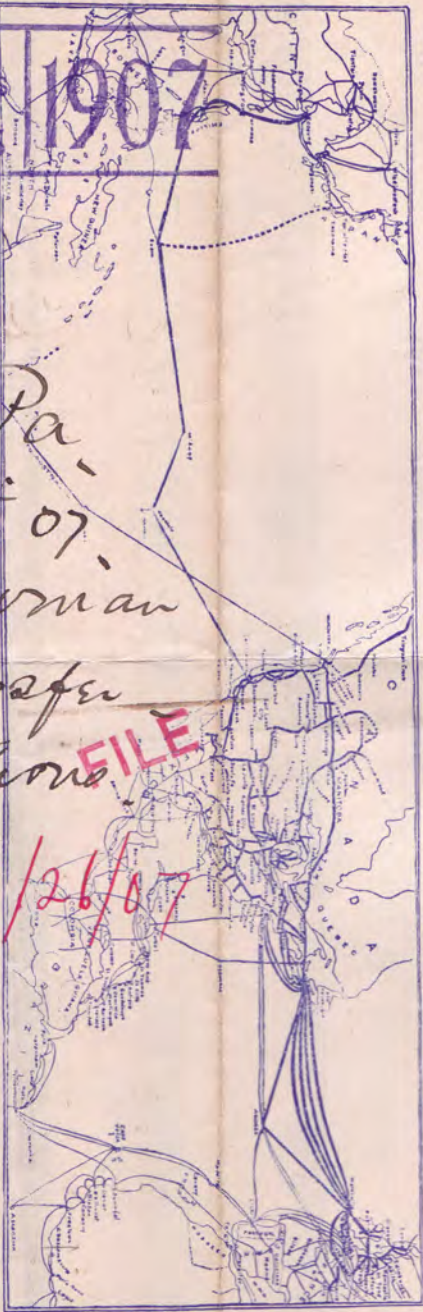

THE POSTAL TELEGRAPH-CABLE COMPANY, (INCORPORATED)

For forwarding messages or delays, the sender of a message should order it **REPAID**; that is, the amount charged back to the originating office for communication. For this one-half the regular rates charged in addition. It is agreed between the sender of a message and the Postal Telegraph-Cable Company that said Company shall not be held for mistakes or delay in the transmission of a message, or for any delay in the delivery of any repeating message beyond fifty times the amount received for sending the same; unless for mistakes of clerks in the transmission of a message, or for any delay in the working of its lines, or for errors in cipher or obscure messages. And this Company is hereby specially instructed to deliver a message without liability for mistake or delay in the transmission of a message, or for any delay in the delivery of any repeating message, and payment of premium thereon, at the following rates, in addition to the usual charges for repeating messages: one per cent. for any distance not exceeding 1,000 miles and two per cent. for any greater distance. No responsibility regarding messages attached to this Company shall be assumed and accepted at a greater distance a special charge will be made to cover the cost by one of this Company's messengers, he acts for that purpose the agent of the sender. In all cases where a special charge will be made to cover the cost of messages will be delivered free within the published free delivery limits of term of office. In all cases where a special charge will be made to cover the cost of such delivery of messages or telegrams or telegrams in any case where the claim is presented in writing within sixty days after the message is filed with the Company for transmission. This is an **ISSUANCE MESSAGE** and is delivered and accepted at the conditions marked above. It cannot be guarded against only by repeating a message back to the sending office for comparison. No employee of this Company is authorized to vary the foregoing terms.
