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In making estimate as to funds available for the balance of the fiscal year, it would greatly facilitate the work if the amount charged against the appropriation for general support, 1907, for stationary and blanks furnished by the Department could be known here; many of the invoices filled in answer to my requisitions fail to state the value of the articles, and it has therefore been impossible to make entries on receipt of the goods.

The invoices of goods furnished under Departmental contracts through the Indian Warehouses, show an amount of \$13286.15; it is also desirable to know whether or not this agrees with your accounts.
