I inclose herewith copy of a letter dated the 4th instant from Superintendent G. L. Williams of the Pottawatomie Agency, Kansas, in reference to filling two vacancies at that school. In connection therewith I have to state that Anna Minthorne, a graduate of this school, Class 1906, and who is still upon our rolls, is willing to accept the position of assistant matron and, with your approval, will leave here the latter part of the week.

Regarding the other vacancy, I have telegraphed to Superintendent Williams for further information as to the duties of the same. We would like to fill both vacancies but hesitate to send a girl for the position of "assistant" without knowing something about the qualifications required. With your approval, upon receipt of Superintendent Williams's reply we will arrange to send girls to fill both places if practicable.
