

Sir:

I respectfully request that authority be granted for the settlement of an indebtedness amounting to \$60.88 incurred by me in the 3d quarter, 1907, as represented by the voucher inclosed. I have sufficient funds on hand for payment from the appropriation: "Support of Indians in Arizona and New Mexico, 1907". This item is the cost of railroad fare from Carlisle to Fort Wingate, Arizona, incurred by Lt. J. H. Lewis, escort for eleven Hopi youth admitted to this school by order of the Office of Indian Affairs. Office letter Finance January 31, 1907, directed me to submit vouchers for expenditures for approval, and as this item was not included in any of the previous vouchers, it is now respectfully submitted for authority to pay from funds placed to my credit with the Assistant Treasurer, U. S., New York.
