

Sir:-

Complying with the request contained in your Office letter Education, dated the 18th instant, from the Acting Commissioner of Indian Affairs. there are enclosed herewith printed copies of voucher which we printed here at the school for use in connection with the accounting of individual Indian moneys of pupils. We did not print any copies of the last sheet containing the certificates, but there is enclosed a copy embracing such certificates as contained in the form which was forwarded to your office on the 28th of March, and which you returned with your reply dated April 4th.

Of course since the cashier is to receipt for deposits in the name of each pupil in column provided for that purpose, his certificate at the close of the schedule would be superfluous, and we concluded that it would be unnecessary to have the last sheet with certificate printed, but that the certificate of the Superintendent and the Financial Clerk could be typewritten on the last sheet constituting the schedule.
