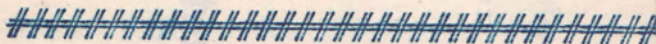

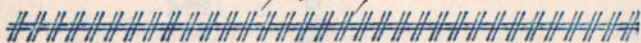


Sir:
