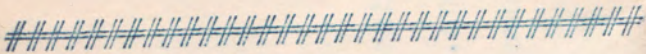

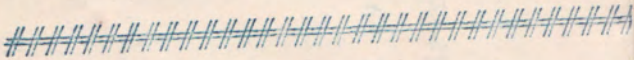


Office letter of June 7, 1907, "Finance, 52282-1907" is at hand, granting me authority to pay an indebtedness amounting to \$15.33 for expenses in recovering a run-a-way pupil, payable from "Indian School, Carlisle, 1907"

By reference to my letter of request, it will be seen that I specified "Miscellaneous Receipts, Class iv" as the fund from which this payment should be drawn. As the balance of the "Indian School, Carlisle, 1907" fund now on hand, is fully absorbed by contracts, authorities, &c. I cannot incur further expenditures against this fund without creating a deficiency; there is, however, an amount of some \$4000. "Miscellaneous Receipts" to my credit, and as this fund is applicable to the same purposes as the Appropriation, it can be used to prevent a deficiency in the accounts of this school for the present fiscal year. Modification of above named authority so as to allow

payment from "Miscellaneous Receipts, Class 1v, instead of the appropriation, is therefore requested, for the expenditure of \$15.23 as above stated.
