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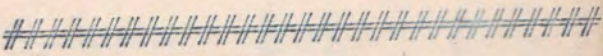

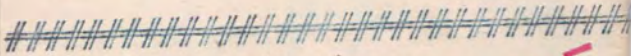

Sir:-

I enclose herewith application of Sadie F. Robertson, matron, for transfer. This application is dated June 7th, which was a day or two after the notification to the other employees of their transfer, and appeared to be in sympathy with them as, to use her own expression, "all her friends seem to be going away". I called Miss Robertson in and asked her the cause of her application for a transfer, as it was not contemplated to make a change in her case. She replied that if that was the case, she was satisfied to remain, but three days later, on the 10th, she has renewed her application without any apparent reason, and without giving any statement as to why she changed her mind again. Under the circumstances, I recommend that her application for a transfer to the position of teacher be granted, and that she be assigned to some school other than Carlisle, as she evidently desires to leave. Under the circumstances, I feel that it would be better that Miss Robertson obtain a transfer, and I therefore request that she be transferred and to a position of teacher for which she thinks she is better fitted than for that of matron, and with which opinion I am more than inclined to agree.


For the benefit of the service, I advise in general that the employees transferred from Carlisle at this time be not assigned to

any school to which any one of the said employees have already been assigned. That is, I think it would be a good thing for the service to have them separated.

In this connection, Miss Robertson's application includes a preference for Albuquerque or Phoenix, to both of which places a transfer has been ordered from Carlisle.
