

Sir:

Referring to your letter (Education 63805/1907) dated July 24th, relative to the transfer of Fred W. Canfield, Boys' Field Agent, and the promotion of James E. Henderson, teacher, to his position, to take effect August 1st, I have to say that I prefer that the salary to be paid Mr. Henderson be \$800 and he is satisfied with that amount. The \$900 was paid to Mr. Canfield in part due to his length of service and experience and I think it better that a new man commencing the duties should not receive the salary of his predecessor of greater experience. I am satisfied that Mr. Henderson will perform the duties efficiently and if so I am willing to promote him another year by increasing the salary to \$900.

I therefore recommend that the \$900 authorized as salary for the boys' field agent for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1908, be reduced to \$800.

Sir:

I have the honor to recommend, based upon the request of the Superintendent of the school, that the salary of the position of Boys' Field Agent at the Indian school at Carlisle be reduced from \$900 to \$800 per annum, to date from and including August 1, 1907; payable from funds applicable. The position will be vacant at that time, and one of the teachers at a lower salary is to be promoted to it.
