I regret to have to report the death, at 9:30 p.m. yesterday, of Henry Rose, an Alaskan pupil, aged 21 years, who was enrolled at this school October 5, 1903. This young man was brought in from the country about a month ago suffering with tuberculosis, which was the cause of his death. The remains will be interred in the school cemetery following funeral services this afternoon.
