Dear Sir;

I am enclosing three letters that are self-explanatory.

Under separate cover I am mailing a calendar that is going to be used by the Carlisle Indian School. This calendar is what we call a daily-date calendar. It proves to be a very important acquisition for any of the largest Indian Schools. I first took the idea from a system used in some of our city Schools, Academies, High Schools, and Colleges. The instructors are beginning to impress upon the students what a calendar means to them in their daily life.

I sent five samples to five of the largest Indian Schools namely; Chilocco, Five Civilized Tribes, Genoa, Haskell Institute, and Sherman Institute. Mr. Lipps of Carlisle was kind enough to donate fifty of these calendars to the school. Thinking that all the other Superintendents would do likewise, I wrote each one of them a letter and sent each one a sample.

after reconsidering the whole idea, I believe that all of the largest schools would appreciate such a service as a compliment from our Honorable Commissioner. With the same little saying of Benjamin Franklin As used on the Carlisle calendar with the compliments of the Hon. Cato Sells printed on it would be very much appreciated and also a very fine Xmas. or New Year's present to the Indian School service. One of these hung in each school-room and shop for the benefit of employees and the Indian students would impress
