
Dear Sir:

I have your letter of March 18 wherein you express a desire to be released from the U. S. Navy.

Carlisle Indian School report for 1917 records you as twenty years of age and in the sixth grade.

You are advised that while the matter has been taken up with the Commandant of Great Lakes Naval Training Station, you should make formal application to your commanding officer for a discharge, as it is unlikely that any consideration will be given requests for discharge from outside sources until the sailor involved has made application for discharge.
