I am in receipt of your letter of January 30, 1918, directing me to make the preliminary arrangements so that certificates of competency to full course graduates of Indian schools may be issued on commencement day. I note further your instructions to send at once a complete list of the students who will probably graduate this year together with name, age on date of proposed graduation, name of tribe, degree of Indian blood and course to be completed in order that preparations of certificates may be fully completed.
