Clara Spotted Horse Yellowtail, being first duly sworn on her oath deposes and says that she is twenty-five years of age and resides on the Crow Reservation about five miles south of Lodge Grass station.

Affiant states that she was a pupil at the Carlisle Indian school from January 1906 to February 1910, remaining at the said school all the time between those dates. Affiant further states that from the Spring of 1908 till the time of her leaving said school (Feb. 1910) she was employed by Superintendent Friedman to do general housework at the Superintendent's cottage on said school reservation. That during such time affiant did the cooking and general housework for the said Supt. Friedman and family.

Affiant states that never during such time or at any other time has she seen or known of intoxicating liquors being used by Supt. Friedman or any members of his family, nor was intoxicating liquor kept in the refrigerator or elsewhere in the house to her knowledge, excepting that on one occasion when Mrs. Friedman was suffering from a broken hip the doctor gave her some sherry wine. Affiant further states that she does ~~not~~ know of Supt. Friedman ever drinking or using intoxicating liquors, and that she has never so stated.
