Inspector E. B. Linnen:

Sir:

The charge made regarding the falsifying of records of students expelled so as to make it appear that such students went home on leave or were simply dropped from the roll is correct at least according to what I now learn from Rose Lyons, Hiram Chase and Francis Eastman.

Exhibits A. and B. contain the names (underlined) of such students and in addition contain the names of all students expelled during the past two years.

Exhibits C. D. E. F. and G. prove that it was intended that these pupils should be reported in this way. It should be stated however that in all such cases the matron or disciplinarian making the report simply follows instructions from the Superintendent or the Supts. clerk.

If as sometimes happens no instructions are forthcoming then at the end of the quarter the principal teacher sends to the Superintendent clerks' office for such instructions. Exhibit H. shows how such information is obtained.

The typewritten matter in the last column was placed there by Mr. Meyer in response to request from the principal teacher, after the other matter reported in same column, had been prepared from reports on hand for example, Exhibits C. D. E. F. and G.
