Sir:

Referring to your Office letter (Education 68175/07) dated August 10, 1907, forwarding copy of appointment of Miss Dora S. Lecrone of Elwood City, Pa., as teacher at this school at \$600 per annum, I have to say that the appointee has not yet reported for duty, nor have we received any communication from her.

In case Miss Lecrone does not accept this appointment, the name of Miss Barbara S. McHargue of Boreing, Ky., is suggested for reinstatement and appointment to this position. Miss McHargue wrote the Superintendent July 8th stating she would like to secure a position as teacher at Carlisle. After getting a favorable report from Supt. Brown of the Morris School in her case she was written July 18th and advised to make application to your Office for reinstatement and appointment to this school. At that time she was told there was a vacancy here at \$660, but as there is now no such vacancy she may be willing to accept the position at \$600.
