To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D.C.

Sir:-

I recommend that the position of assistant disciplinarian at \$480 per annum be authorized for this school. It is intended to appoint one of our Indian boys who is in every way proficient and able to attend to the work required of him, which will be confined to night duty between the hours of 9 P.M. and 5:45 A.M.

The necessity for one to be constantly on duty at night at the Large Boys Quarters has been apparent for a great while, and attempts to impose this duty upon the disciplinarian and his assistant, who are busy all day, has not proven satisfactory, or advisable. In addition to the night duties at the dormitory, it is expected that this employee will also, - to some extent - act in the capacity of night watchman. It is better, however, that the position be designated as Assistant Disciplinarian, rather than watchman, because of the fact that his duties coincide with those of the disciplinarian.

If my recommendation is carried out, and the position authorized, I would like to recommend the appointment of the Indian boy above referred to.
