Referring to your Office letter (Education 93163/07, File 162) dated Nov. 29, 1907, in regard to filling the position of fireman at this school, I have to state that we have arranged, by the detail of capable Indian boys to perform the duties of fireman, so that for the time being at least I do not deem it necessary to have the position now vacant filled by the appointment of an eligible. I do not care to recommend any increase of salary in this position at the present time as suggested by you.

The other position of fireman at \$420 per annum is being satisfactorily filled by M. T. Dewalt, who is temporarily employed. Steps have been taken by him to qualify for appointment to such position, and if he makes an eligible percentage it is hoped that it may be arranged, in accordance with the Civil Service rules, to have him permanently appointed.
