My dear Mr. Lipps:

Answering your letter of April 7 requesting information as to the purpose of certain authorities, you are advised as follows:

Authority 96892-1913 is in connection with authority 108527-1913 for increasing the salary of the Assistant Disciplinarian from \$700 to \$900 per annum, effective September 16, 1913.

*Stator*

Authority 117473-1913 is in connection with authority 143063-1913 for the abolishment of a position of one physician at \$720 per annum and another physician at \$660 per annum and the establishment in lieu thereof one physician at a salary of \$1400 per annum, effective January 1, 1914.

*Stator*

Claim 242996 is for \$1.02 in settlement for transportation of supplies January 23, 1914.

Claim 246995 is for the settlement of transportation of supplies, 50¢, January 17, 1914.

All of these authorities are from the fund "Indian School, Carlisle, Pennsylvania, 1914".

Authority 114591 is for 50 dozen hair brushes at \$2.48 per dozen, amounting to \$124, dated December 6, 1913.
