Replying to your letter of the 11th inst relative to outing wages due Robert Anderson of Lewiston, N. Y. for the summer of 1910, I have to say a letter was received from Mrs. Anderson relative to this matter. I enclose this letter with one written to Mr. Neely at the same time. Since this time another letter, a circular which we use for such cases has been sent to Mr. Neely. He did not reply to either of these notices. It was my intention to have the Field Agent collect this debt as soon as he was well started on his outing trip.

I have this morning wired Mr. Neely and have a reply from him to the effect that he will send me money order for the amount due on Monday. I will then send a check to Robert.

I might add that Robert Anderson was placed for the summer with Mr. Neely April 6, 1910 but failed to carry out his agreement by deserting June 26, 1910.
