Sir:

The Office is in receipt of your request of December 14, 1912, for authority to sign and approve a check against the account of Carrie Dunbar, deceased, in the sum of \$13.07, in order to close the account and make payment to Francis Dunbar, sister of the decedent. If Francis Dunbar bore the expense incident to the burial of her sister the amount might on this ground be turned over to her as a partial reimbursement for the expenses incurred; otherwise it should be shown that the proposed payee is the heir or else the consent of the heirs is procured before authorizing the disbursement.

If the decedent was possessed of an allotment at the time of her death this money should be transferred to the jurisdiction under which her allotment is situated to be distributed with the balance of the estate.
