I have your telegram reading as follows:

"Mollie Mantell wires here to Superintendent Carroll that she is going to be married Tuesday and wants all balances to her credit. What do you recommend?"

In reply I have to say that Mollie Mantel is to marry a young Indian by the name of Alfred LaMont on Tuesday. LaMont is a young man with a thoroughly good reputation, industrious and reliable. They both leave for the West immediately after their marriage, which is to take place in the Catholic Church in Carlisle on Tuesday morning, following which the young people are to have a reception in my home.

I would prefer not to recommend that all the balance of her funds be turned over to her at this time. She still has a sufficient balance in this school to cover her needs until they get out West and settle down at which time the Superintendent of the Osage Agency can satisfy himself in his own mind as to what is best with
