Hereafter in rendering the abstract of bank accounts covering pupil's funds, you will not be required to give thereon, the year of birth of each pupil. Neither will it be necessary to furnish deposit slips signed by an official of the depositary covering the amounts deposited, nor to submit an itemized statement signed by the Outing Agent showing amounts received.

However, a payors certificate, on form 5-238a signed by the Outing Agent covering the total amount of pupil's funds received by him during the period for which the account is rendered, will be required.
