Sir:

In compliance with your request of the ^{20th} ~~21st~~ instant, authority is hereby granted for you to slaughter 40 hogs for subsistence of pupils, in accordance with the requirements of sections 449-50, Regulations of 1904.

Authority is also granted for you to advertise by means of notices extensively posted in the vicinity of the school and elsewhere, and by inviting proposals from dealers and others likely to be interested, for the sale of 30 hogs and 20 calves, and to sell the same at public auction or private sale, as may be deemed most advantageous, for the highest prices obtainable, at not less, however, than current market value.

Take up and account for the proceeds of the sale as Miscellaneous Receipts, Class IV, and file with the sales-voucher all proposals received together with a list of persons and firms from whom bids are invited, as evidence that the best possible prices are obtained.

Attach a copy of this letter to the vouchers on which

the animals are dropped from your account.
