Sir:

The Office has your request of February 23, 1912, to expend \$100 "for payment of freight and express charges on supplies which are not delivered f. o. b. Carlisle, Pennsylvania, during the fiscal year 1912", and notes in your letter of explanation that this authority is said to be necessary because you "receive at various times shipments by freight of supplies to be used for instructive purposes from manufacturers and other concerns who ship these goods by freight as well as by express, on which the stipulation is that if we pay the expressage or freight these articles are furnished without charge."

The Office is not convinced from your statements that the cases of the kind mentioned in your letter are sufficiently numerous or extensive to justify an authority of the kind presented. The fact remains that these supplies may just as well be shipped you on Government bill of lading

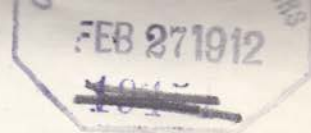
