Sir:

Authority is hereby granted for you to sell to a packing house where a Government Inspector is stationed 23 head of cows recently tested for tuberculosis and found to react under the test; this sale to be subject to a post mortem examination, as requested and for the reason given in your letter of October 30, 1908; the proceeds of the sale to be taken up in your accounts as "Miscellaneous Receipts, Class IV".
