

Authority is hereby granted for you to advertise by means of typewritten posters, to be posted conspicuously in a number of public places in the vicinity of your school and elsewhere and distributed among persons likely to be interested, for the sale of 60 hogs raised on the school farm, and not required for subsistence of pupils, and to sell these, either at public auction or under sealed bids as in your judgment may be best, to the highest bidder, or bidders, for cash, at not less than their current market value, the latter method, where there seems to be little choice, being preferred by this Office.

Take up the proceeds of this sale as "Miscellaneous Receipts, Class IV," and attach a copy of this letter to the voucher on which any of these animals are dropped from your property return.
