The Office is in receipt of your inquiry of February 5, 1915, in behalf of Orville Azure regarding the present status of the allotment for which register's certificate was inclosed.

The schedule of Turtle Mountain allotment selections approved by the Department February 1, 1911, shows the following selection for which trust patent 357749 was issued October 1, 1913, and sent to the Superintendent of the Turtle Mountain School for delivery:

OS Glasgow Series, Axilla Azure, 17 years, son of Isadore Azure, the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 30 N., R. 58 E., containing 160 acres.

Although the register's certificate, which is returned herewith, indicates that this application was filed under the fourth section of the general allotment act, under Departmental ruling all selections of public lands by enrolled members of the Turtle Mountain band of Chippewas are held and treated as selections under the Act of April 21, 1904, (33 Stat. 189-194).
