Mr. Dortch :

It has always been customary to ask \$500 authority for eye treatment, and this covers transportation of pupils to and from Phila. in order to have the services of specialists who do the work free; but while in the hospital (Will's Eye, etc.) they must pay board. Spectacles are paid for out of this amount, if pupils have no money.

It has been customary also to ask for authority for the purchase of special articles of diet needed for patients at the school hospital.

The authority has, or used to be, asked in the form here used.
