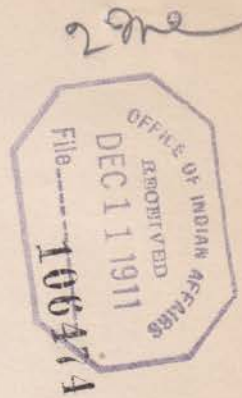

I hereby transmit a letter I received from Dr. Daniel W. White, Indian Trachoma Expert, with the following recommendations. There are some conditions existing among the students in regard to the trachoma question with which I am not absolutely familiar, and I would be very glad to have Dr. White sent to the school, so that I could take these matters up and get a better understanding of conditions than I can get from the text books. The trachoma condition at the school has improved very much, but I would like to feel that I was absolute master of the situation. I think if Dr. White were here and we were able to go over some of these cases that are obstinate and are not yielding to treatment as they should have done, the conditions would be improved. I therefore request that you recommend to the Department that Dr. White be sent here for a few weeks at least.
