I respectfully report that Henry Buffalo, a sixteen year old student enrolled here from the Red Cliff Agency in Wisconsin, died about nine o'clock last evening. He had been enrolled here only since January the 15th, last.

The cause of his death was pulmonary tuberculosis. Arrangements had been made some weeks ago to have him sent to his home, but a sudden change for the worse made it inadvisable to move him on the date planned for, and since then his condition had become more and more serious.

Funeral services were conducted this afternoon in the school auditorium, and the body will be escorted to the boy's former home at Bayfield, Wisconsin, by his mother.
