I have your circular letter dated June 5 relative
to industrial training, and have to say in reply that
taken generally, the industrial training for the students
at Carlisle is of a very high order. The instruction in
girls' industries has not been as efficient and comprehensive as it should be, and I am sending under separate cover
request for materials which will improve the instruction
and assist in systematizing the work. Several requests
have also been sent in for additional equipment for the
boys' industries, and as the funds are available out of this
year's appropriation, I respectfully urge that administrative
action be given them promptly.
