

Lipps's gives sufficient information to warrant a definite answer.

The Office should be advised as to the degree of Indian blood of this applicant; on what reservation she has rights; age; where she attended school up to this time; how long; what grade she attained; whether she is a graduate of any Government school, etc.

When full information has been received, consideration will be given. If she is over-age, and has any special purpose or course in mind, that should be stated also.
