Sir:

Referring to that part of Office letter of Aug. 18th and marked "Education - Administration, 59289-1909, A.V.S.", in regard to the facts leading to the enrolment of Spencer Williams, I respectfully report that this young man made application to be admitted to this school to receive additional training, claiming that he had no chance to compete with white men in the east without special training for special work.

The privilege of enrolling was then extended him for the reason that he was a graduate of this school and because his record as a former student was such that he seemed worthy of being given the assistance he desired.



Favorable consideration of his application was further induced by the fact that the Government was being put to such a very nominal expense for his transportation from Philadelphia and that the very small outlay was to go such a great way in doing possible good for the

young man by allowing him the privilege of receiving the special training he so much desired.

In order to remove the exception to the enrollment of this young man during the third quarter of the last fiscal year, I respectfully request that this matter should be considered as soon as may be convenient.

It is noted that one is 28 years old and **no specific**
authority for his enrollment has been granted; that all the
others with one exception were over-age when enrolled **in**
the third quarter of the past fiscal year. In the cases of
the six pupils 21 and 22 years old, enrollment is approved in
order to remove exceptions from your accounts.

All pupils 21 years old are in the over-age class and authority for their enrollment should be asked. When enrolled, they may be retained without further authority, up to the age of 24. Pupils 24 years old and over should not be continued without specific authority. Requests for authority to enroll pupils over 21 years should set out reasons in each case, and when granted the file number of the letter of authority should be placed opposite their names on **each** quarterly attendance report.

On August 5 the Office wrote you about the case of Spencer Williams, listed as 28 years old. You are requested to give the circumstances of this young man's return to the school; whether it was on his own application or at the solicitation of some officer of the school.

Approval of his enrollment ^{for the third quarter} awaits answer and explanation from you.
